Rossville- Barbara A. Dudley, 74, passed away Friday, July 8, 2011 at Stormont Vail Hospital in Topeka.

She was born June 2, 1937 at Simpson, Kansas the daughter of James Roy and Melba Marguerite Huffman Gentry. Barbara lived in Simpson until she was in the 5th grade before moving to Rossville. She graduated from Rossville High School in 1955.

Mrs. Dudley had been a secretary for the Kansas Legislature for many years and had been Senator Anthony Hensley's secretary since she started working for the state. She earlier had worked for the Topeka Chamber of Commerce. Barbara was a member of the Rossville United Methodist Church and also was a member of Jimmie Lillard Post No. 31 Auxiliary of the American Legion.

Barbara was preceded in death by her parents, a brother Bobby Gentry and a sister Betty Dick.

On August 17, 1958 she was united in marriage to Bryce "Pete" Dudley at Rossville. He survives of the home.

Other survivors include her children, Robyn Dudley, Silver Lake, Brenda Powell, Temple, TX, and Mark Dudley, Silver Lake; a brother, Billy (Beverly)

Gentry, Rossville; her granddaughter, Alayna Powell.

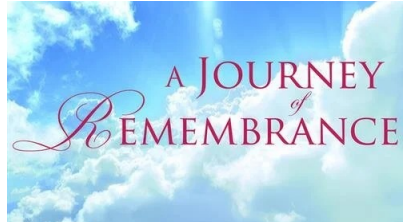
