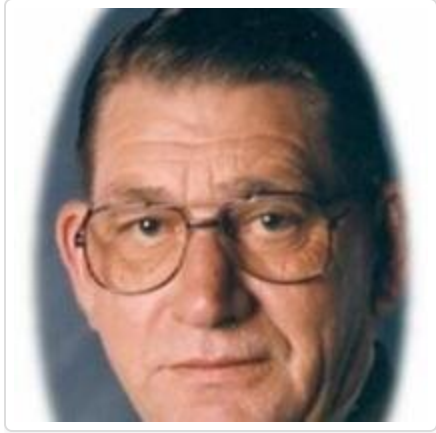




Delbert E. "Gene" Teeter

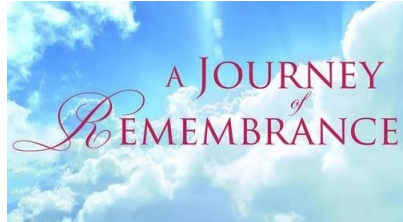
