Vincent John Lenherr passed away Wednesday, June 08, 2011 at the St. Marys Manor. He was born on February 29, 1936, the fifth of seven children born to Paul J. & Regina A. Lenherr. He attended Immaculate Conception Grade School in St. Marys, Kansas and graduated from St. Marys High School in 1957.

After graduation, John moved with his family to Omaha, Nebraska where he worked at Creighton University in the maintenance department as a painter for 13 years. Upon the death of his mother and his father's retirement in 1970, John, along with his father, returned to St. Marys where he was employed by the St. Marys Manor until his retirement. He was a member of Immaculate Conception Parish and a 3rd degree member of the Knights of Columbus Council #657.

John was preceded in death by his parents, Paul & Regina Lenherr, and two sisters Regina A. Simonton (Fred), & Mary Cecilia Lenherr, SCL. He is survived by three sisters: Josepha Mulvihill (Leo) of Perry, Kansas; Sister Letitia Lenherr, SCL, Sheridan, Wyoming; and Ann Henry (Don), Rio Rancho, New Mexico; and one brother Paul L.
