



## Kenneth Mulanax

November 16, 1938 - September 7, 2010

DELIA-Kenneth L. Mulanax, 71, a longtime resident of Delia passed away Tuesday, September 7, 2010 at his home.

Kenneth was the sixth child born to Lewis and Eunice Mulanax on November 16, 1938 at Mayetta. He moved to the Delia community and graduated from Delia High School.

Ken worked as a state grain inspector in Topeka for 10 years and then at Fleming Foods for 28 years. He worked at Harrah's Prairie Band Casino for six years before he retired. Mr. Mulanax was a member of Immaculate Conception Catholic Church and Christ the King Catholic Church in Topeka. He was also a member of the Citizen Band Potawatomi Nation. In his earlier years of life Ken was a member of the COUNTRY SUNDOWNER BAND. He played the guitar and fiddle.

He was preceded in death by a son, John; two sisters, Vi and Alta along with a brother Bill.

On July 29, 1967 he was united in marriage to Elizabeth Stueve at Sacred Heart Church in Delia. They lived in Delia until his death. She survives of the home.

Other survivors include his children, Dan Mulanax, Topeka, Kevin Mulanax, Osage City and Marcy (Jeff) Prasatsin of Topeka; two grandsons, Trevor Mulanax and Jula Prasatsin; two brothers, Jim, Topeka and Irvan, Rossville.

Mr. Mulanax was cremated. Memorial Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:00 A.M. Saturday, September 11, 2010 at Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in St. Marys. There will be a Prayer Vigil/Rosary at 7:00 P.M. Friday at Piper Funeral Home in St. Marys where family will receive friends after 6:00 P.M.
