Mildred C. Philipp, 103, died on April 23, 2011, at home in Florence, AZ, where she lived with her daughter and son-in-law Alice and Elmer Stroh. She enjoyed flowers and gardening, sewing, creating and altering clothing, crocheting, dancing including square dancing, bowling and bird watching. She loved the Catholic Church. In her early married years she lived in Emmett, KS, moving to Colby, KS, in 1942. In the late 1950s she and Ralph moved to Ellis, KS. There she lost her first husband Ralph Borgeson and later married Carol Philipp. After Carl died she bought and lived in a home for several years in Granbury, TX, near her daughter Carol. Her last move took her to Florence, AZ, where she bought and lived in a home near another daughter Alice. The last 5 years of her life she lived with her daughter Alice

and her husband Elmer. The family will be eternally grateful for the care and devotion with which Alice and Elmer cared for her.

Survivors include two sons, Ralph Borgeson, Jr., of Gladstone, MO, and Dennis Borgeson of Centennial, CO; two daughters, Alice Stroh of Florence, AZ, and Arnold, CA, and Carol Kautz of Granbury, TX; two brothers, Arthur Haug of Lawrence, KS, and Robert Haug of Fort Myers, FL; 13 grandchildren; 17 great-grandchildren; and 4 great-great-grandchildren.
